Death Certificate (each)	\$27.00^(*)
Wills Notice (Registration or change) (each)	\$17.00
Application for Search of Wills Notice	\$20.00^(*)
Each additional alias	\$5.00

(*) An additional \$1.50 (GST Taxable) will be levied when using BC Online.

An inclusive charge of \$60.00 will be made for Rush Service applications for Certificates or photocopies of births, deaths and marriages. Rush services are processed within 24 business hours of receipt of the application. (not including courier time). A Certificate will only be issued upon confirmation of a record held. If no record of the event (birth, death or marriage) is found, a fee will be charged for the search process.

In addition, an inclusive charge of \$53.00 will be made for search requests submitted when 24 hour service is requested and provided.

PROBATE FILING FEES

<u>Gross Value of Estate</u>	<u>Fee</u>
\$0.00 to \$25,000 (free)	\$0.00
\$25,000 up (basic flat fee to file application)	200.00
\$25,000 to \$50,000 ⁽¹⁾ \$6 per \$1,000: additional fee	\$150.00
\$50,000 and over \$14 per \$1,000 ⁽¹⁾	

For example: The gross value is **\$237,431**, being the total of assets on which probate fees are payable (see **Fees** payable in Appendix to Chapter III B-3)

Flat filing fee	\$200.00
Fee on the next \$25,000 to \$50,000 (25 x \$6)	\$150.00
Additional fee on remainder ⁽²⁾ : 188 x \$14	<u>\$2,632.00</u>
Total amount payable	<u>\$2,982.00</u>

There is a simpler method to calculate the probate fees:

- Round up the value of the estate to the next \$1,000.00 (in the example above, to 238);
- Multiply the result by 0.014 (in the example above, the result would be \$3,332.00);
- Deduct \$350.00 from the result: \$3,332.00 less \$350.00 = \$2,982.00.
