

## **Notes on Completing a P10 Affidavit of Assets and Liabilities for Domiciled Estate Grant**

The text in Part III “**Intangible Personal Property in British Columbia (including bank accounts, intellectual property and other valuable items that cannot be touched by hand)**” may be changed to “**Intangible Personal Property anywhere in the world (including bank accounts, intellectual property and other valuable items that cannot be touched by hand)**”.

The “powers that be” are working on correcting this mistake but our form is correct. Paragraph 3 in the body of the Affidavit refers to:

3. Attached to this affidavit as Exhibit A is a Statement of Assets, Liabilities and Distribution that discloses
  - (a) the real property and tangible personal property within British Columbia, and intangible personal property **anywhere in the world**, that passes to the applicant in the applicant’s capacity as the deceased’s personal representative,
  - (b) the value of that property, and
  - (c) the liabilities that charge or encumber that property.

In addition, if there are no assets outside British Columbia, Exhibit B may be deleted.
